The land measuring approximately 0.7 hectares lies to the south of Cumberland Avenue, Helensburgh, and is largely triangular in shape. It is bounded to the west by a strip of deciduous woodland in separate ownership, beyond which are the back gardens of Ardencaple Drive. To the east, it is bounded by the back gardens of Fraser Avenue. The land falls within the postcode unit of G84 8QP.

Castle Woods lie to the south of Rhu Road Higher, Helensburgh, beyond the sports complex of Lomond School, and form an important natural extension of the designated local nature reserve of Duchess Woods to the north.

Castle Woods falls within the postcodes of G84 8QR and G84 8YL. It is bounded to the west by new housing development (Castle Court) on the site of the former Jutland Court, to the south by the back gardens of Ardencaple Quadrant and to the east by the back gardens of Bannachra Drive.
